

GUIDELINES FOR THE AUTHOR OF THE ARTICLES

1. The articles presented in the last AGBJ Annual Conference shall be published in the journal.
2. Only those articles shall be incorporated in the journal, which are research oriented and are original.
3. The articles must be computer typed on A4 size paper and only on the one side of the paper.
4. The type must be double spaced and latter must be of 12 points size.
5. Maps accompanied the articles must be computer printed in A4 size or less.
6. The articles must have a brief abstract at the beginning with not more than 200 words, followed by key words.
7. References be given at the end in the standard format.
8. Author must give their full postal address with designation for correspondence and Mobile number.
9. Standard format for References

Sources of reference may be Books, Journals/Magazines and internet. They need to be arranged at the end of the research paper in the given standard format :

Book : 1. Author's full name (last name first) 2. Full title (including subtitle, if any) 3. Edition (if second or later edition) 4. Number of the volume (if multivolume) 5. City of publication 6. Publisher's Name 7. Year of publication.

Article in a Scholarly Journal : 1. Author's Name (Last name first) 2. Title of the article 3. Title of the Journal 4. Volume no. 5. Year of publication 6. Page nos. (Beginning to end of the article)

In the body of the text, any reference may be acknowledged in this manner within brackets : (surname of the author: year of publication : page number), for eg. (LOOMBA : 1999 : 32)

Newspaper/Magazine Article : 1. Author's Name (last name first) 2. Title of the article 3. Title of the periodical 4. Date of publication 5. Inclusive page nos. of the article

Internet Source : 1. Author's Name 2. Title of the document 3. Title of the scholarly project / database, periodical / professional / personal site 4. Name of the editor of that site 5. Date of electronic publication or last update 6. Name of institution/organistion associated with the site 7. Date of access (of the source) 8. Network address/URL (uniform resource locator)

10. Appendices

All appendices should be numbered consecutively and typed on separate sheet.

11. For the contributors who wish to use computers in place of typewriter are requested to adopt the following instructions :

MS-WORD; Font-Times New Roman 12 point, double spacing throughout with margin of 25 mm in A4 size bond paper. All sections of the paper should be organized under appropriate heading. The title page should include title, author's name and complete address including e-mail, Fax No. and Mobile or Phone number.

12. All contributors are requested to submit two copies of the research paper, along with the C.D. (MS Word) of the paper.
