Guidelines for Authors

Paper Title (in upper case)

Author (s):

(Designation, Institution, Email and Contact No. of all)

Abstract

The abstract should summarize the content of the paper (**Word Limit** = 200-250 words).

Keywords

Give 4 - 6 keywords in alphabetical order, separated by comma.

Structure of the paper

Arrange the body of the paper in the order: Introduction (including statement of the problem, previous work, research gap, purpose, and its significance) - Study Area - Objectives – Hypothesis/Research Questions -Methodology - Result and Discussion - Conclusion -Acknowledgement – References. (**Word limit: strictly not exceeding 5000-6000 words**)

Note: While writing, avoid unnecessary capitalization.

Table

Format: *.doc or *.xls; Captions must be mentioned on the top of the table and Sources, if any must be mentioned below the table.

Figure (Graphs, Diagrams, Maps and Photographs)

Format: *.jpg; Captions and Source are must; Dimension: Width = 3.5 inch or 6 inch with legible labels

Only a limited number of tables and figures should be included in the paper.

Note: The manuscripts must be typed in double-space in MS Word with plagiarism within 10% limit.

References

A reference list **MUST** be included using the following as a guide.

1. Only cited text references are to be included.
2. References must be numbered and ordered alphabetically
